	0.84	For harder to control weeds
IPCO MCPA Amine 600 + 150 g/L Mecoprop-P	0.34 – 0.84 + 2.2	For control of mixed weed populations in seedling grasses
IPCO MCPA Amine 600 + 150 g/L Mecoprop-P	0.34 – 0.84 + 3.4	For control of mixed weed populations in established turf
IPCO MCPA Amine 600 + 150 g/L Mecoprop-P + 480 g/L Dicamba	0.34 – 0.84 + 1.5 + 0.06	For control of mixed weed populations
