

**IPCO Vigil® WB for Grassy Weed Control**

In addition to grassy weed control, [Vigil WB](#) may be tank mixed with several and various broadleaf herbicides<sup>#</sup> such as [IPCO 2,4-D Ester 700](#), [MCPA Ester 600](#), [Dichlorprop-DX®](#), [Leader®](#) or [Logic® M](#) for even greater weed control.

**Guidelines for Use:**

Crop	Recommended Leaf Stage	Rate of <a href="#">Vigil WB</a> <sup>#</sup>	Weeds Controlled
Spring & Durum Wheat	1-6 leaves on main stem plus 3 tillers	312 mL/Ac	Green Foxtail, Yellow Foxtail, Barnyard Grass and Wild Oats
Spring Barley	1-5 leaves on main stem plus 2 tillers		

\* [Vigil WB](#) to be applied to spring barley should be tank mixed with a crop oil concentrate or with a broadleaf herbicide to avoid crop injury
