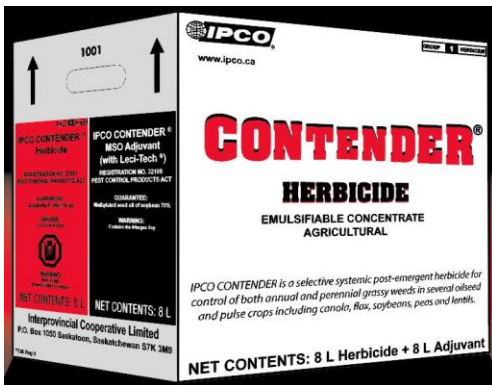

IPCO Contender® Herbicide

IPCO CONTENDER is a new selective post-emergent herbicide that controls several problem annual and perennial grassy weeds in a wide range of pulse and oilseed crops including: lentils; peas (field and processing); chickpeas; soybeans; canola; flax; and several other crops.



Benefits:

- Selective, systemic, and dependable control of a wide range of problem annual and perennial grasses in pulse, oilseed, and soybean crops
- Wide window of application for most grassy weed species
- Control of volunteer corn in soybeans (including glyphosate tolerant corn) and in several other crops
- Control of quackgrass and suppression of foxtail barley in pulse and oilseed crops

Guidelines for Use:

Packaging: 1 case contains Contender Herbicide (8 Litres) and Contender MSO Adjuvant (8 Litres)

Rates: 1 case treats 40 acres. (Apply 0.2 Litres per acre of each product in 40 L/acre water)

Water Volumes: For ground applications use a minimum of 40 L/acre water. To improve coverage and control under heavy weed pressure, use a higher water volume, up to a maximum of 160 L/acre

Weed Control at 40 acres per case (0.2L/acre Contender Herbicide):

Weeds Controlled	Weed Leaf Stage
Wild Oats*	1 – 5 Leaf to Early Tillering
Volunteer Corn	2 to 6 Leaf
Volunteer Cereals*: Volunteer Barley, Volunteer Wheat; and Volunteer Oats	2 Leaf to Early Tillering
Barnyard Grass, Fall Panicum, Old Witchgrass, Proso Millet, and Yellow Foxtail	2 Leaf to Early Tillering
Quackgrass**	2 to 6 Leaf
Foxtail Barley**	3 Leaf to 4 Leaf + Tillers

*Generally best control if applied prior to tillering

** Suppression at 0.2 L/acre rate of Contender. Use a higher rate of 0.3 L/acre Contender to control quackgrass
